Year Round Calendar

School For All Seasons (SFAS), located within Isanti Intermediate School, is the year round school option for all Cambridge-Isanti students in grades K-5. Our program builds strong character with all students and has been recognized by the state of Minnesota for promising practices in character education.

SFAS strives to incorporate STEAM topics into all core curriculum, as well as a variety of other areas. STEAM stands for Science, Technology, Environment, Arts, and Mathematics. Students have opportunities to expand on a topic of interest during each trimester. These explorations culminate in a themed evening for students and parents.

Like the traditional option, there is no cost to send your child to School For All Seasons. Busing is available for all students located within the Cambridge-Isanti Schools boundary.

The year round schedule consists of three trimesters, with longer breaks in between. It also includes a six week summer break.

Early Childhood Screening

The state of Minnesota requires that all children entering kindergarten have an Early Childhood Screening done or scheduled by the first day of school. Hearing, vision, speech, cognitive, and motor abilities are the areas of development that will be assessed during the screening. This is a FREE and simple check of how your child is growing and developing.

Safety & Security

The safety of your child is our highest priority. We work to ensure school grounds and building entrances are carefully monitored. Students are not allowed to leave during the school day unless signed out by an authorized adult. All staff are required to wear an ID badge throughout the school day. All visitors must check in with a valid picture ID at the school's main office and wear a visitor badge while in our schools.

Before & After School Care

Adventure Center Child Care is a fee-based program available from 6:00 am until the start of the school day and from the end of the school day until 6:00 pm. This program provides gym time, arts & crafts, computer lab, and other activities for children in grades K-5. Preschool care is also available. Immunizations

Families must provide records that their child has had immunizations or submit a notarized conscientious exemption with the school **before** your child starts school.

The immunizations that are required for Kindergarten are as follows:

Registration Checklist

Gather the following items before getting started with your child's enrollment:

- Immunizations**
A copy of your child's immunization record. You may submit partial immunization information at the time of registration and email, mail, fax, or drop off any changes to the records that occur before the start of school.
- Proof of child's age and legal name**
A copy of your child's official birth certificate, passport, or approved official documentation.
- Proof of residence**
A copy of the front page of a lease or rental agreement, property closing papers, or current utility bill if it has the parent/guardian's correct name and address. If your child is not a resident of Cambridge-Isanti Schools, please complete the Non-Resident Student Enrollment form under Open Enrollment found at <https://www.c-ischools.org/become-a-bluejacket>.
- Early Childhood Screening**
If your child was screened through C-I Schools, we already have their screening on file. If your child was screened in another district, contact that district and have them fax or mail their results to the school your child will be attending.

Frequently Asked Questions about Kindergarten Registration



- **I cannot find the birth certificate. Can my child still enroll?**
Yes - Your child may still enroll, but we need a copy of the official birth certificate, passport, or approved official documentation by Kindergarten Round-Up. For a fee, you can obtain a certified birth record from the recorder's office at any Government Center of the state in which they were born.
- **Can I enroll my child even if they have not had the early childhood screening?**
Yes - Turn in the kindergarten registration paperwork and then register online for a screening appointment at <https://c-ischools.ce.eleyo.com/courses/category/ecfe/87/early-childhood-screening>. If you have questions, call the district's Early Childhood Program at (763) 691-6691. You may also call Isanti County Public Health or your child's physician. State law mandates that screening take place before starting kindergarten.
- **My child was screened in another district. What do I do?**
Contact the district where they were screened and have them fax or mail your child's screening results to the school your child will be attending.
- **Can my child attend kindergarten every other day?**
No - Since the legislature passed the *2013 Education Finance Bill*, Cambridge-Isanti Schools is pleased to provide all-day, every day kindergarten to all of our families with kindergarten students for no additional fee.
- **My child has not had their 5-year-old shots. Should I still turn in the enrollment papers?**
Yes - Enrollment paperwork should be turned in along with any immunizations that your child has had so far. Additional immunizations can be turned in to the school as they are completed. State law mandates immunizations be completed before starting school. A notarized exemption statement must be submitted if a required immunization is contrary to your conscientiously held beliefs.
- **My child will be waiting another year before going to kindergarten or will not be attending school in C-I Schools. Do I need to do anything?**
Yes - Please call the school in which your child would attend, and we will update our records so that you are taken off of the mailing list and don't get reminder calls in the spring.
- **When is Kindergarten Round-Up? Should my child attend?**
Yes - Plan to attend with your child. We want students to become familiar with their new learning environment to support a healthy transition to school day success.

Kindergarten Readiness



Parents can best prepare children for school by reading to them, talking to them, giving them a wide variety of experiences, and setting the stage for them to learn through play. On the first day of school, teachers would like to see children who are ready and eager to learn with the wide variety of skills and experiences they need to handle the challenges of kindergarten. We understand that each child develops at his or her own pace, but we find the children who can do the majority of the skills listed below are more successful in the kindergarten classroom.

SOCIAL/EMOTIONAL

- Likes the thought of entering kindergarten
- Speaks clearly in complete sentences most of the time
- Can cooperate and interact with other children
- Can work independently for at least five minutes
- Is able to communicate with adults
- Accepts minor disappointments or limits without tears
- Is willing to try new things
- Understands and follows directions that include at least two steps

INTELLECTUAL

- Shows an interest in books and reading, and can listen to a story for five minutes
- Holds book and turns pages correctly
- Knows some songs, rhymes
- Recognizes some letters
- Identifies labels and signs in the environment (McDonalds, Walmart, etc.)
- Pretends to read and write
- Knows first and last name – can write first name without help
- Knows names of family members
- Recognizes similarities and differences in sizes, shapes and colors of objects
- Can tell and retell familiar stories or experiences
- Can count, and recognizes numbers
- Has had a variety of experiences: library, park, zoo, etc.
- Has an understanding of how to use crayons, paint, glue, pencil and scissors
- Expresses ideas with drawings, rather than scribbles
- Is willing to try to complete a task

PERSONAL NEEDS

- Demonstrates self-help skills in personal care (washing hands, dressing, eating, bathroom use)
- Recognizes own possessions: jacket, lunchbox, etc.
- Cooperates with clean-up

If you have questions or concerns regarding your child's readiness for kindergarten, please contact your child's primary school principal or Cambridge-Isanti Early Childhood program. Preschool programs for children ages 3-5 years old are available. There is a fee associated with preschool, but scholarships are available. Contact Early Childhood at (763) 691-6691 for more information.

Is your child eligible for kindergarten?

If your child will be five years old on or before September 1, 2021, your child is eligible to attend kindergarten during the 2021-2022 academic year.
